- 5. Households/individuals will fund the deficit from government and loan funding
- 6. The amount of scholarship awarded increases as the level of need increases
- 7. The amount of loan awarded increases as the level of need reduces.
- 8. Students/Parents in the "less needy" and "needy" category will have to pay at least Ksh. 13,438/= from their own pockets towards fees.
